The annual newsletter begins each year thanking those who assisted with the maintenance and progress of Riverside Cemetery:

- 1-Everyone who provided monetary donations.
- 2-Everyone who provided change of address & addresses of the next generation of those responsible for the care of Riverside Cemetery.
- 3-Creighton Sangster maintaining equipment & donating plastic barrels for storing donated recyclables.
- 4-Worth Bros. Welding providing a steel cage for cremation plots.
- 5-Steven Pinkham Excavating donating top soil & providing gravel.
- 6-Arsenault Monuments donation of monument bases.
- 7-Everyone who donated recyclable items, especially cottage owners who transport their urban recyclables to us.

Old Business:

Of the current 250 households contacted each year it is estimated 200 next generation households exist. A donation only covers every person living within the household the donation is received from. When CIAONH was established in 1949, door to door canvassing was the method of fundraising. As people moved from the area it was assumed, when someone started a new household, they would donate as did their parents. This method of fund raising worked well with several generations. The current generation, that is now donating, has aged to the point where your committee seriously need the contact information for the next generation.

The 2020 newsletter only generated six new addresses. Please provide the names and addresses of adults that have moved from your household. Your committee needs to know, if there is enough financial support, from charitable donations to take us into the future. If we do not get the level of co-operation required from the next generation, a two tier system will soon be necessary. The options of replacing or supplementing the current fundraising model are very limited.

The original charitable donor feature will remain for those who support it. Considering charitable organizations operate under strict (not for profit) regulations, a separate entity will need to be created whereas a business will be formed. Your committee is dedicated to trying all options available, under the regulations of operating a charitable organization; unfortunately we are forced to consider other options. A mail-out vote will be conducted before changes occur.

If necessary a separate committee will manage the business (for profit) model, requiring households that do not donate, pay a burial fee and sign into an annual maintenance contract. Unfortunately the fees & contracts will need to be considerable to offset the decrease of charitable donations.

A two tier system may be avoided if your committee receive the names & addresses of the next generation. The next generation will have the same option of opting out of donating, as did their parents. If there is enough support from the next generation we can proceed with our existing method of fundraising.

New Business:

For those of the next generation households that are receiving the annual newsletter for the first time, the following is included in each mail-out; permission slips to print your name(s) as a donor and to whom in memory of. If we have reason to conduct a mail-out survey soliciting opinion's or vote's, it will, as well be sent to every household. Anyone registering a burial plot(s) must contact the committee for the proper form(s).

During 2020 Covid 19 delivered a substantial decrease to the fundraising campaign. Due to the reduction of monetary donations, since Aug 1st 2020 we have been receiving donated recyclable items, in effort to recoup some of the financial loss. Items requested; bottles, cans & automotive/marine batteries.

A red shed signed "recyclables" is located next to the Baptist Church door step & is open Monday through Saturday 8AM until 8PM. Please do not leave items at the white maintenance shed. Thanks to everyone who supported this program, please continue & spread the word to others.

We have extended the pick-up area to include areas between Stormont & Boylston with the following schedule; the 1st Saturday of the month, Coddles Harbour to Stormont. 2nd Saturday, New Harbour to Charlos Cove. 3rd Saturday, Lundy to Boylston. The 4th Saturday is reserved for sorting & counting. If a pick-up is required please contact Clyde 902-387-2221 or river-side@xplornet.com.

Effective March 1st, 2021 CIAONH will consider gifts-in-kind, (non- cash gifts), type of donations. Donors will receive a tax receipt for the fair market value of the items donated. Until Covid 19 restrictions are lifted, donated items will be sold by reserved bid via e-mail.

Examples of items requested; property, vehicles, water craft & any other item that is manageable and has a resalable value. CIAONH reserves the right to refuse any item that is deemed unmanageable or non-profitable. For more information visit www.cra.ca charities & giving.
